We are submitting this Discretionary Use Application for approval to use our attached guest house as a rental suite on our acreage.

As all existing buildings and utilities already exist, including us being on city water and having a septic tank/pump out system in good repair, we will require no construction prior to being able to rent out this dwelling.

There will be no lighting or signage requirements, and since we are getting dust control applied, there will be no increase in dust issues.

We predict that traffic volumes will have minimal impact as we intend to rent this suite as a long term rental, and preferably to either a family unit, or to a maximum of 3 tenants (such as students or contract workers).
