That permits for burning be issued as follows:

Burning barrels and fire pits for household garbage and open barbecue pits on a seasonal basis, April 1 to October 31, required only once. Burning barrel and fire pit seasonal permits are not valid during a fire ban.

Permits for burning brush, sloughs, etc. are valid for a specified time period and require permit holders to notify the Provincial Emergency Communication Centre (Burn Centre) the day and time of burning and when the fire is extinguished (1-866-404-4911).

Burning without a permit, or not following the instructions of the fire permit, will result in a fine of \$1500.

If the burn is to take place within 4.5 km of a forest, calling the Prince Albert Forest Protection Area office at 306-953-3244 to acquire a burning permit from SERM prior to burning.

A fire ban may be issued at the discretion of the R.M. of Prince Albert Council and/or Reeve and Administrator. No permits will be issued during a fire ban. Any permits previously issued will be cancelled once a fire ban has been issued.

Permits will be available at the R.M. Administration office and are also available through the R.M. of Prince Albert website.
